AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF NANTUCKET TO ACQUIRE LAND FOR AND DEVELOP A SANITARY LANDFILL AREA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Nantucket, for the purpose of
2 paying the costs of acquiring land and developing a sanitary
3 landfill area is authorized to borrow from time to time such sums
4 as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate,
5 _____, and may issue bonds or notes therefor which
6 shall bear on their face the words, Town of Nantucket, Sanitary
7 Landfill Loan, Act of 1972. Each authorized issue shall con-
8 stitute a separate loan, and such loans shall be paid within twenty
9 years from their dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall
10 be in excess of any statutory limit, but shall, except as provided
11 herein, be subject to chapter forty-four of the General Laws,
12 exclusive of any limitation or requirement contained in sections
13 seven or eight thereof.

1 SECTION 2. The costs of developing the said sanitary
2 landfill area shall consist of all costs necessary for the purpose,
3 and, without excluding any such costs, shall include expenditures
4 for engineering, surveying, architectural and planning services,
5 the construction of access roads and water and power lines on
6 and off the project site, the construction or installation of such
7 facilities, structures or buildings as may be required for the safe

8 and efficient use of the project, and the purchase of any
9 equipment necessary in connection therewith.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
