AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF BARNSTABLE COUNTY BE CLASSIFIED IN GROUP 4 UNDER THE RETIREMENT LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The definition of Group 2 in paragraph (g) of subdivision (2)
2 of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as most recently
3 amended by chapter 602 of the acts of 1960, is hereby further
4 amended by inserting after the work "Guard", in line 24, the
5 words: — uniformed personnel of the Barnstable county bureau
6 of criminal investigation.
