AN ACT PROVIDING TENURE OF OFFICE UNTIL AGE SEVENTY FOR DONALD E. WHITEHOUSE, INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF PURCHASING AGENT OF THE CITY OF EVERETT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The tenure of office of Donald E. Whitehouse,
2 incumbent of the office of purchasing agent of the city of
3 Everett shall be unlimited during good behavior until he attains
4 age seventy unless incapacitated by physical or mental disability
5 from performing the duties thereof, but he may be removed for
6 cause after hearing in the manner provided by section forty-three
7 of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.
