RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO LIMITING THE NUMBER OF STRIPED BASS WHICH MAY BE CAUGHT IN A SINGLE DAY BY ONE PERSON.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of representa-
3 tives, the director of marine fisheries or his designee, and two
4 persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby established
5 for the purpose of making an investigation and study of the
6 subject matter of current house document numbered 1928,
7 relative to limiting the number of striped bass which may be
8 caught in a single day by one person.
