AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE CITIES AND TOWNS TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO REIMBURSE THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT FOR CERTAIN EXPENDITURES MADE UNDER THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY EMPLOYMENT ACT OF 1971.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,
2 any city or town may appropriate money for the purpose of
3 reimbursing the Federal Government for amounts expended from
4 funds allocated under the Federal Emergency Employment Act
5 of 1971 for salaries or wages paid on account of services rendered
6 on or after September the first, nineteen hundred and seventy-
7 one to persons who did not meet the requirements of said Act.
