**AN ACT EXCLUDING CERTAIN VEHICLES FROM THE PROVISIONS OF
THE LAW REQUIRING THE ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES OF TITLE
OF MOTOR VEHICLES.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 Paragraph (a) of section 2 of chapter 90D of the General Laws,
- 2 as appearing in section 1 of chapter 754 of the acts of 1971, is
- 3 hereby amended by inserting after the word "tricycle", in line
- 4 13, the following: — ;(9) Vehicles which are registered as of
- 5 September first, nineteen hundred and seventy-two in accordance
- 6 with provisions of chapter ninety, provided that a certificate of
- 7 title shall be required if any such vehicle is transferred; (10)
- 8 Trailers having gross weight of three thousand pounds or less;
- 9 (11) Passenger vehicles that are ten or more years old.
