AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES TO HAVE FLAPS OR GUARDS TO REDUCE SPRAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The first paragraph of section 7 of chapter 90 of the General
- 2 Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the sentence amended
- 3 by chapter 170 of the acts of 1970 the following sentence: —
- 4 Every passenger motor vehicle which is equipped with tires which
- 5 extend beyond the fenders or body of such vehicle and which is
- 6 operated in or upon any way shall be equipped with flaps or
- 7 suitable guards to reduce such spray or splash to the rear and
- 8 sides.
