**AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE TREASURER TO RECEIVE FUNDS
FROM THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF FISHERIES AND GAME.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*
