AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POSITIONS OF DEPUTY DIRECTOR AND CHIEF COUNSEL OF THE DIVISION OF EMPLOYMENT SECURITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The second sentence of section 9K of chapter
2 23 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 4 of chapter 479
3 of the acts of 1935, is hereby amended by adding the following
4 words: – ; provided, that the director may, subject to the
5 approval of the governor, appoint one or more deputy directors
6 and a chief counsel who shall not be subject to said chapter
7 thirty-one or the rules and regulations made thereunder or to
8 section nine A of chapter thirty.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary
2 of section nine K of chapter twenty-three of the General Laws, as
3 amended by section one of this act, any person who,
4 immediately prior to the effective date of this act, holds the
5 position of deputy director or chief counsel of the division of
6 employment security shall continue in such position without
7 impairment of civil service status, seniority, retirement and other
8 employment rights, and without interruption of service within
9 the meaning of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws, and
10 without reduction in compensation or salary grade.
