AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SALEM TO REFUND CERTAIN TAXES ERRONEOUSLY ASSESSED UPON AND COLLECTED FROM COMPUTER SERVICES, INC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The city of Salem is hereby authorized to refund to Computer
2 Services, Inc., a Massachusetts corporation having a usual place of
3 business in said city, the sum of fifteen hundred dollars, the same
4 being the amount collected by said city from said corporation as
5 taxes in the years nineteen hundred and sixty-nine and nineteen
6 hundred and seventy upon certain personal property in said city
7 which was exempt from local taxation.
