AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE POSTING OF FOUR-WAY STOP SIGNS AT CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS IN CITIES AND TOWNS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 85 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after section 10A the following section: —

3 *Section 10B.* Selectmen in towns, and the aldermen or other  
4 board or officer having charge of ways in cities and towns, may  
5 by regulation authorize the positing of four-way stop signs at  
6 intersections under their jurisdiction, notwithstanding the pro-  
7 visions of section two.
