AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LEOMINSTER TO INSTALL STREET SIGNS ON PRIVATE WAYS OPEN TO PUBLIC USE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Leominster is hereby authorized to
2 appropriate funds to install street signs on such private ways as
3 are opened to public use as may be designated by the city
4 council.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
