AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF CANTON TO PAY A SUM OF MONEY TO MILDRED MORSE ALLEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Canton is hereby authorized to
2 appropriate and after such appropriation the treasurer of said
3 town is authorized to pay to Mildred Morse Allen the sum of six
4 hundred and sixty-four dollars as reimbursement of the over-
5 payment of a sewer assessment.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF CANTON TO PAY A SUM OF MONEY TO MISSSES HINES ALLEN

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in joint session, on the 15th day of March, 1871, and by the Senate and House of Representatives in joint session, on the 15th day of March, 1871.

SECTION 1. The town of Canton is hereby authorized to appropriate and after such appropriation the treasurer of said town is authorized to pay to Misses Hines Allen the sum of \$1000 and each-four dollars as reimbursement of the cost of payment of a note executed.

SECTION 2. The act shall take effect from its passage.
