12 American Charitable Society, Priests Association of East Boston  
13 and the Boston Urban Affairs Council; and

14     *Whereas*, In all his endeavors Reverend Monsignor Pitaro has  
15 exhibited a strong sense of dedication and duty, a warm and  
16 sympathetic approach to the problems of his parishioners, his  
17 constituents and to the citizens of the Commonwealth; therefore
