AN ACT DESIGNATING THE BRIDGE OVER THE WESTFIELD RIVER
CONNECTING THE TOWNS OF WEST SPRINGFIELD AND AGAWAM AS
THE VIETNAM VETERANS MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 The bridge being constructed over the Westfield river con-
- 2 necting the towns of Agawam and West Springfield shall, upon
- 3 completion, be known and designated as the Vietnam Veterans
- 4 Memorial Bridge in memory of all veterans who have served
- 5 overseas while in military service. A suitable marker bearing such
- 6 designation shall be attached thereto by the department of Public
- 7 Works.
