AN ACT PROHIBITING DISCRIMINATION IN ADMISSION OF BLIND STUDENTS TO STATE COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 151C of the General Laws
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after clause (c) the following 3 clause:-
