AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH AND THE TRUSTEES OF WESTBORO STATE HOSPITAL TO TRANSFER CERTAIN LAND IN THE TOWN OF WESTBORO TO THE DIVISION OF FISHERIES AND GAME.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The commissioner of the department of mental health and
2 the trustees of Westboro State Hospital are hereby authorized
3 and directed to transfer all their interest in and to, without
4 cost, a certain parcel of land located in that section of the
5 town of Westboro referred to as the "Warren Colony" and
6 fully described in a deed from "Merriam to the Trustees of the
7 Westboro Insane Hospital". Said deed is recorded in the
8 Worcester County registry of deeds in book 1687 on page 442,
9 dated July 3, 1901. Said transfer shall be subject to the ap-
10 proval of the commissioner of administration and finance and
11 the deed to be approved as to form by the attorney general.
