By Mr. Chmura of Ludlow, petition of Steve T. Chmura (by vote of the town) that the town of Ludlow be authorized to use for school purposes certain land held by said town for park purposes. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF LUDLOW TO USE FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES CERTAIN LAND HELD BY SAID TOWN FOR PARK PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The town of Ludlow is hereby authorized to use for school
2 purposes a parcel of land now held by said town for park
3 purposes bounded and described as follows: that section of
4 Veterans park, lying easterly of land of one Sroka; southerly
5 by land on Pease; westerly on land of the Ludlow Fish and
6 Game Club; and northerly of the Ludlow high school baseball
7 and football playing fields. Said playing fields lying on the
8 northerly side of Higher Brook as described in Article 52 of
9 the town warrant for the nineteen hundred and seventy-two
10 town meeting.
