The committee on Rules of the two branches, acting concurrently, to whom was referred the Resolve providing for an investigation and study relative to the availability of Spanish speaking and other foreign language speaking medical personnel and social workers in institutions of mental health and retardation (House, No. 1792, changed), and the Resolve increasing the scope of the special commission established to make an investigation and study relative to the human development of those confined within the correctional system of the Commonwealth (House, No. 5415), report recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 5864) ought to be adopted.

1 *Ordered*, That the joint committee on Social Welfare be
2 authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court to
3 make an investigation and study the subject matter of current
4 House Resolve providing for an investigation and study by a
5 special commission relative to the availability of Spanish speak-
6 ing medical personnel and social workers in institutions of
7 mental health and retardation in the Commonwealth and any
8 other related matters thereto (House, No. 1792, changed), and
9 the Resolve increasing the scope of the special commission
10 established to make an investigation and study relative to the
11 human development of those confined within the correctional
12 system of the Commonwealth (House, No. 5415).

13 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state
14 house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, and the production of
15 books and papers, may travel within the commonwealth, and
16 may expend for legal, clerical and other assistance and expenses
17 such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said committee
18 shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation
19 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legisla-
20 tion necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by
21 filing the same with the Clerk of the House on or before the
22 fourth Wednesday of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-
23 two.
