The committee on Education, to whom were referred the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2062) of Patricia Bonner-Lyons and Royal L. Bolling for legislation to authorize community control of public education in certain cities; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2647) of Martin A. Linsky, Mimie B. Pitaro, Paul Murphy, Francis K. Dwyer, Maurice E. Frye, Jr., and Royal L. Bolling for legislation to authorize the formation of local school boards in certain cities, report recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 5912) ought to be adopted.

1 *Ordered*, That the committee on education be authorized to
2 sit during the recess of the General Court for the purpose of
3 making an investigation and study of the subject matter of
4 current house documents numbered 2062, authorizing the
5 community control of public education; and 2647, authorizing
6 the formation of local school boards in certain cities.

7 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state
8 house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may travel within the
9 commonwealth and may expend for clerical and other assistance
10 and for expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

11 Said committee shall report to the general court the results of
12 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
13 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recom-
14 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the
15 house of representatives on or before the last Wednesday of
16 December, nineteen hundred and seventy-two.
