RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE LICENSING OF AUTOMOBILE CLUBS AND REGULATION BY THE DIVISION OF INSURANCE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BANKING AND INSURANCE.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, consisting of two  
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of representa-  
3 tives, the general manager of the American Automobile Associa-  
4 tion or his designee, the general manager of the Automobile  
5 Legal Association or his designee and the commissioner of  
6 insurance or his designee. Said special commission shall make an  
7 investigation and study of the subject matter of current house  
8 document numbered 5594, relating to automobile clubs and  
9 providing for their licensing and regulation by the division of  
10 insurance of the department of banking and insurance. Said  
11 Commission shall report to the general court the results of its  
12 investigation and study and its recommendations, if any, together  
13 with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recommenda-  
14 tions into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of  
15 representatives on or before the third Wednesday of December in  
16 the current year.
