1 *Ordered*, That the joint committee on Public Service be  
2 authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court to make  
3 an investigation and study of the subject matter of current house  
4 documents numbered 627, providing for an investigation and  
5 study by a special commission relative to funding the state  
6 retirement system; and 2727, providing for an investigation and  
7 study by a special commission relative to funding the state  
8 retirement system; and 3030, providing for an investigation and  
9 study by a special commission relative to the financing and  
10 administration of public employee retirement systems in the  
11 Commonwealth.

12 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state  
13 house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, and the production of  
14 books and papers, may travel within the Commonwealth, and  
15 may expend for legal, clerical and other assistance and expenses  
16 such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said committee shall  
17 report to the General Court the results of its investigation and its  
18 recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation  
19 necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by filing the  
20 same with the Clerk of the House on or before the fourth  
21 Wednesday of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-two.
