AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CONTINUANCE OF RENT CONTROL IN THE CITY OF LYNN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter eight hundred and
2 forty-two of the acts of nineteen hundred and seventy, the
3 following question shall be placed upon the official ballot to be
4 used at the state election to be held in the current year: —

5 “Shall rent control be continued
6 in the city of Lynn?”
