1 *Ordered*, That the Speaker of the House of Representatives is
2 hereby authorized to appoint a special committee of five
3 members of the House to sit during the recess of the General
4 Court to conduct an investigation and study of the operation and
5 management of Salisbury Beach and the Salisbury Beach Reser-
6 vation under the control and supervision of the department of
7 natural resources with particular reference to the lack of safety
8 precautions due to a shortage of lifeguards and any matters
9 relative thereto which said committee deems reasonable and
10 proper. Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the
11 state house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, shall have the power
12 to summon witnesses and to require the production of books,
13 records and paper as it deems necessary.

14 Said committee shall report to the house of representatives the
15 results of its investigation, and its recommendations, if any, by
16 filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on
17 or before August fifteenth, nineteen hundred and seventy-two.
