### AN ACT FURTHER PROTECTING CERTAIN ANIMALS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 76 of chapter 131 of the General Laws as added by  
2 section 76 of Chapter 802 of the Acts of 1967 is hereby amended by  
3 deleting the phrase “. . . provided, that, anyone authorized by the  
4 owner of lands may so remove a chipmunk, fox, flying squirrel, red  
5 squirrel, porcupine, skunk, weasel, wildcat or woodchuck . . .”.
