## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Five.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO HOME EDUCATION PROGRAMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to  
2 the contrary, no city or town, no school committee of any city,  
3 town, regional school district, or superintendency union, nor any  
4 of the members of any school committee, nor any employee of a  
5 school committee shall be liable in any lawsuit for damages based  
6 upon any common law, statutory, or constitutional cause of action  
7 to any person for any act taken or any decision which a school  
8 committee or prior school committee or school employee may  
9 have made in good faith and in the exercise of sound discretion and  
10 in compliance with law authorizing a home education program  
11 under the provisions of this section.
