### AN ACT PROVIDING HEALTH CARE FOR THE HOMELESS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1 of Chapter 117 of the General Laws, most recently  
2 amended by Chapter 758 of the Acts of 1975, is hereby amend-  
3 ed by striking out the third sentence of the first paragraph and  
4 substituting the following:

5 Such assistance shall include payment for physician office  
6 visits, basic dental care, drugs, laboratories, durable goods,  
7 eye care, home health care, and inpatient, outpatient, and  
8 chronic care in municipal, county, and private non-profit  
9 hospitals, provided that the department shall require the use  
10 of such generic drugs as are available and appropriate.
