AN ACT RELATIVE TO TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS BY A TOWN FINANCE COMMITTEE OR ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 33B of chapter 44 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 15 of chapter 766 of the acts of 1971, is hereby
3 further amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting in
4 place thereof the following sentence: — A town finance committee
5 or advisory committee may by a majority vote transfer from one
6 line item of a departmental budget to another line item in the same
7 departmental budget at the request of the respective department
8 head and a majority of the board of selectmen. No approval, other
9 than that expressly provided herein shall be required for any
10 transfer under the provisions of this section.
