AN ACT DETERMINING THE AMOUNT OF COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENTS IN RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES, PENSIONS AND ANNUITIES OF RETIRED PUBLIC EMPLOYEES AND CERTAIN BENEFICIARIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subject to the provisions of section one hundred and two of
2 chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, as most recently amended
3 by Chapter five hundred and forty-two of the acts of nineteen
4 hundred and eighty, the retirement allowance, pension or annuity
5 of every former employee of the commonwealth or of any county,
6 city, town, district, housing or redevelopment authority, or the
7 Massachusetts Turnpike Authority, or of the spouse or other
8 beneficiary of any such former employee who is receiving a retire-
9 ment allowance pension or annuity shall, beginning July first,
10 nineteen hundred and eighty-five be increased by five percent.
