AN ACT GUARANTEEING RETIREMENT RIGHTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 31, Section 37 of the M.G.L.A., as amended, is hereby
- 2 further amended by adding the following sentence: — No person
- 3 shall suffer loss of retirement rights under Chapter 32.
