AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A NINE CENT PER MILE TRAVEL DEDUCTION FROM INCOME TAXES FOR CERTAIN TRAVEL DONE WHILE PERFORMING VOLUNTEER WORK FOR CERTAIN CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection B of section 3 of chapter 62, of the General Laws as
2 most recently amended by section 19 of chapter 233 of the acts of
3 1983, is hereby further amended by adding the following subpara-
4 graph: —

5 (10) In the case of an individual who uses his automobile while
6 doing volunteer work for a charitable or nonprofit organization an
7 amount equal to nine cents per mile traveled while engaged in such
8 volunteer work.
