AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF THE EXCISE  
IMPOSED UPON VESSELS MOORED OR DOCKED IN CERTAIN HARBORS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter sixty B of the General  
2 Laws, the excise imposed upon vessels under the provisions of said  
3 chapter shall, as to vessels habitually moored or docked in a  
4 harbor in which more than one municipality owns property, be  
5 assessed and collected by the municipality which maintains such  
6 harbor.
