AN ACT RELATIVE TO FORFEITURE OF MONIES SEIZED IN CERTAIN CRIMINAL CASES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 47, sub-section d, of Chapter 94C of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended in line 20 by inserting after the word "agency" the  
3 words "or the Sheriffs of the several counties".
