AN ACT AUTHORIZING CITIES AND TOWNS TO ENACT LAWS CONTROLLING HANDGUNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 21 of chapter 40 of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by section 1 of chapter 644 of the acts of 1981, is hereby
- 3 further amended by adding the following clause: —
- 4 (25) For prohibiting, regulating, or controlling the possession,
- 5 carrying, or ownership of pistols, revolvers or other handguns.
