RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT AND FINANCING OF A NO-FARE PREPAID TRANSIT SYSTEM.

1     *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three  
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of representa-  
3 tives, and three persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby  
4 established for the purpose of making an investigation and study  
5 relative to the establishment and financing of a no-fare prepaid  
6 transit system. Said commission shall, in the course of its investiga-  
7 tion and study, evaluate the means of funding. Said commission  
8 shall make its final report to the general court on or before the first  
9 Wednesday of May, nineteen hundred and eighty-five.
