

HOUSE No. 791

By Mrs. Murray of Cohasset, petition of Mary Jeanette Murray relative to authorizing the committee on health Care to make an investigation and study of heart and liver transplants. Health Care.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Five.

Ordered, That the Committee on Health Care be authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court for the purpose of making an investigation and study of the subject of the current House document numbered: — 2141 of 1984, legislation requiring that provision be made for financial assistance to persons receiving heart and liver transplants. Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the State House or elsewhere, may hold public hearings, may travel within the Commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and other services and expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefore. Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of such legislation necessary to carry such recommendations into effect by filing the same with the clerk of the House on or before the first Wednesday of December, nineteen hundred and eighty-four.
