

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF ESSEX TO PAY A SUM *Chap.295*
OF MONEY TO MARION KELLEY OF HAVERHILL.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a moral obligation, the county of Essex may pay to Marion Kelley of Haverhill a sum not exceeding five hundred and eighty-five dollars and fifty cents, to compensate her for expenses of hospital and medical care and for loss of earnings due to injuries received by her in the course of her duties in accompanying an insane person who was being committed to an institution for the insane by the central district court of northern Essex.

SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance, during the current year, by the county commissioners of Essex county, but not otherwise.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO PAY A SUM *Chap.296*
OF MONEY TO JOHN S. DOHERTY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a moral obligation, the city of Boston may pay to John S. Doherty of said city a sum not exceeding one thousand dollars, for personal injury sustained by him on August twenty-seventh, nineteen hundred and forty-four, as a result of falling through an open hatch on the steamboat "Stephen O'Meara".

SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance by vote of the city council of said city, subject to the provisions of its charter, but not otherwise.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO PAY A SUM *Chap.297*
OF MONEY TO JOHN J. CONNORS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a moral obligation, the city of Boston may pay to John J. Connors of said city a sum not exceeding two hundred and five dollars for property damage to his motor vehicle resulting from the negligent operation of a motor vehicle owned by said city.

SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance by vote of the city council of said city, subject to the provisions of its charter, but not otherwise.
