

Accompanying the fourth recommendation of the Division of Public Employee Retirement Administration (House, No. 207), Public Service.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO SURVIVOR BENEFITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subdivision (2) of section 7 of Chapter 32 of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out words "twenty-
3 one" as they appear in line 106 of the 1988 Official Edition, and
4 inserting in place thereof the words "twenty-two".

1 SECTION 2. Subdivision (2)(b) of section 9 of Chapter 32 of
2 the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the word
3 "death" as it appears in line 59 of the 1988 Official Edition, the
4 words "or who are over said age and under age 22 and full time
5 students at an accredited educational institution."

1 SECTION 3. Subdivision (2)(d) of section 9 of Chapter 32 is
2 hereby amended by striking out the words "twenty-one" as they
3 appear in line 77 and line 83 of the 1988 Official Edition, and
4 inserting in place thereof the words "twenty-two".

1 SECTION 4. Subdivision 2 of section 26 of said Chapter 32
2 is hereby amended by striking out the words "twenty-one" as they
3 appear in line 60 of the 1988 Official Edition, and inserting in place
4 thereof the words "twenty-two".

1 SECTION 5. Section 100 of said Chapter 32 is hereby
2 amended by striking out the words "twenty-one" as they appear
3 in line 36 of the 1988 Official Edition, and inserting in place thereof
4 the words "twenty-two".
