AN ACT RELATIVE TO LICENSE RENEWAL FEES CHARGED TO THE ELDERLY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
- 2 to the contrary, the fee charged for persons aged seventy years
- 3 and over for the renewal of motor vehicle operator's license issued
- 4 by the Commonwealth shall be reduced by fifty percent.
