AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE  
DISTINCTIVE NUMBER PLATE LABELS TO VETERANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The sixth paragraph of section 2 of chapter 90 of the General
- 2 Laws, as appearing in the 1984 Official Edition, is hereby amended
- 3 by inserting after the fourth sentence the following sentence: —
- 4 The registrar may, upon payment of the registration fee as
- 5 required in section thirty-three furnish to owners of pleasure
- 6 passenger vehicles special labels of a distinctive type, to be affixed
- 7 to number plates, indicating service to the nation as a veteran of
- 8 a particular campaign.
