AN ACT ELIMINATING ANY MANDATORY EXPENDITURE FOR ART IN PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 42C of Chapter 579 of the Acts of 1980 is hereby
2 amended by striking out in the last sentence of the fourth
3 paragraph of said section the following words: — “provided,
4 however, that each contract shall provide that not less than one
5 per cent of the cost of a construction project be expended for art;
6 provided, further, that not more than one hundred thousand
7 dollars be expended.”
