AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF INCOME AND THE AMOUNT OF THE WHOLE ESTATE FOR CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS WHEN DETERMINING THEIR ELIGIBILITY FOR CERTAIN REAL ESTATE TAXATION EXEMPTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Clause Forty-first of section 5 of chapter 59 of
2 the General Laws, as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is
3 hereby amended by striking out, in line 743, the word “six” and
4 inserting in place thereof the word: — twelve.

1 SECTION 2. Said clause Forty-first of said section 5 of said
2 chapter 59, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by strik-
3 ing out, in line 745, the word “seven” and inserting in place thereof
4 the word: — fifteen.

1 SECTION 3. Said clause Forty-first of said section 5 of said
2 chapter 59, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by strik-
3 ing out, in line 747, the word “twelve” and inserting in place
4 thereof the word: — eighteen.

1 SECTION 4. Said clause Forty-first of said section 5 of said
2 chapter 59, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by strik-
3 ing out, in line 749, the word “fifteen” and inserting in place
4 thereof the word: — twenty-four.
