AN ACT RELATIVE TO MEMBERSHIP ON THE MASSACHUSETTS BOARD OF REGENTS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of Chapter 15A of the General Laws as found in the
2 1988 Official Edition, shall be amended in line 4 by inserting after
3 the words — “Organized Labor” the words — “Three graduates
4 of the Massachusetts Public Higher Education system shall be
5 appointed to the Massachusetts Board of Regents of Higher
6 Education of whom one shall be a graduate of a Massachusetts
7 Community College, one shall be a graduate of a Massachusetts
8 State College and one shall be a graduate of a Massachusetts
9 Public University”.
