AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPELLATE JURISDICTION OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES CONTROL COMMISSION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 67 of chapter 138  
2 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1984 Official Edition,  
3 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 5, the word "Modifying"  
4 and inserting in place thereof the words: — renewing, modifying.

1 SECTION 2. The third paragraph of said section 67 of said  
2 chapter 138, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after  
3 the word "action", in line 17, the words: — consistent with the  
4 commissioner's decision.

1 SECTION 3. The fourth paragraph of said section 67 of said  
2 chapter 138, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after  
3 the word "revoke", in line 29, the words: — , declare forfeited.

1 SECTION 4. The fifth paragraph of said section 67 of said  
2 chapter 138, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out,  
3 in line 31, the word "suspend" and inserting in place thereof the  
4 words: — modify, suspend.

1 SECTION 5. The sixth paragraph of said section 67 of said  
2 chapter 138, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after  
3 the word "modifying", in line 42, the word: — , suspending.
