The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-One.

AN ACT REGULATING THE FUTURE OF EMPLOYMENT OF EXECUTIVE SECRETARIES, COMMISSIONERS, AND DEPUTY COMMISSIONERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 6A of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 7 the following section: —
- 3 Section 7A. No secretary, commissioner, or deputy commis-
- 4 sioner within one year after his last employment be employed by,
- 5 act as agent or attorney for, or directly or indirectly receive
- 6 compensation from any person who has any dealing with the
- 7 commonwealth which are considered to be particular matters, as
- 8 defined in section one of chapter two hundred and sixty-eight A,
- 9 and in which the commonwealth or a state agency has a direct
- 10 and substantial interest and which was under his official
- 11 responsibility as a secretary, commissioner, or deputy commis-
- 12 sioner at any time within a period of two years prior to the
- 13 termination of his employment.
