AN ACT REGULATING THE FILING FEE FOR APPEALS FROM TAX ASSESSMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7 of Chapter 58A of the General Laws, as amended by
2 Chapter 385 of the Acts of 1986 is hereby amended by adding the
3 following after the words "under the provision of section three
4 B of chapter seven": — Where an appeal is taken with regard to
5 assessment of only a portion of a parcel and where the
6 commissioner of administration bases the entry fee on the
7 valuation in dispute, the entry fee shall be determined according
8 to the valuation of only that portion of the parcel which is in
9 dispute.
