AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE TERM LEBANESE PEACE KEEPING FORCE VETERAN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 "Lebanese Peace Keeping Force Veteran" shall mean any
2 person who performed such wartime service and received a
3 campaign medal for such service during the period commencing
4 August twenty-fifth, nineteen hundred and eighty-two and ending
5 when the President of the United States shall have withdrawn
6 armed forces from the country of Lebanon, except that for the
7 purposes of Chapter thirty-one, it shall mean all active service of
8 one hundred and eighty days of active service between the dates
9 of August twenty-fifth, nineteen hundred and eighty-two and
10 April tenth, nineteen hundred and eighty-four.
