RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF INVOICES OF VENDORS DOING BUSINESS WITH THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission to consist of three
2 members of the Senate, three members of the House of
3 Representatives, and three vendors doing business with the
4 Commonwealth appointed by the Governor is hereby established
5 for the purpose of making an investigation and study of the
6 procedures, regulations, delays relating to the invoice process for
7 vendors doing business with the Commonwealth and their impact
8 on the number, quality and financial condition of those vendors
9 and making recommendations to modernize and speed the
10 payment of invoices from such vendors.
