AN ACT RELATIVE TO PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR CERTAIN PERSONS
OVER SIXTY-FIVE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The forty-first clause of section 5 of Chapter 59 as appearing
2 in Chapter 967 of the Acts of 1977 is hereby amended by striking
3 out the word "seventieth" in lines three, six and eight and inserting
4 in place thereof in each instance the word "sixty-fifth", and by
5 striking out the words "seventy years of age" and inserting in place
6 thereof in each instance the word: — sixty-fifth.
