

By Mr. Morrissey of Quincy, petition of Michael W. Morrissey relative to the licensing of elevator contractors. Public Safety.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-One.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO ELEVATOR CONTRACTORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 In accordance with the General Laws of the Commonwealth
2 of Massachusetts, Chapter 143, Section 71C, as most recently
3 amended by Chapter 684 of the acts of 1972, be further amended
4 by adding Paragraph 3 as follows:

5 (3) All companies doing work in the Commonwealth of
6 Massachusetts on the installation, modernization, repair and
7 maintenance of elevators, shall be licensed. The initial fee for such
8 license shall be one thousand dollars. Licenses shall be issued for
9 two years and shall be valid throughout the Commonwealth and
10 shall not be assignable or Transferable.

11 The fee for each subsequent renewal, every two years, shall be
12 one hundred dollars. The rules and regulations for the licensing
13 called for in this paragraph shall be administered by the Board
14 of Elevator Regulations. The Board may revoke or suspend any
15 corporate elevator license for cause, after notice and hearing, and
16 shall suspend any license that is not renewed.
